

## APPLICATION PROCEDURES & ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS FOR THE ERNEST I. & EURICE MILLER BASS SCHOLARSHIP FUND

On June 11, 1969, Mr. and Mrs. Ernest I. Bass, Dallas, Texas, created this scholarship fund in order to aid high school graduates in securing a four-year college education. The fund is administered by HighGround Advisors (formerly Baptist Foundation of Texas), a Texas nonprofit corporation located in Dallas, Texas.

**ELIGIBILITY:** Applicants must (1) be high school graduates pursuing studies at schools and colleges owned, controlled or supervised by state or area religious conventions cooperating with the Southern Baptist Convention or its successors; and (2) maintain at least a minimum passing cumulative grade point average and a minimum 2.0 GPA for the most recent semester (3) be enrolled full-time (at least 12 hours) unless it is the student's last semester before graduation.

**SELECTION CRITERIA:** Scholarship awards are based on economic necessity and academic performance. **Past awards are no guaranty of future awards.** Any recipient dismissed from an institution for disciplinary reasons shall be ineligible for further aid. Recipients shall not engage in gambling, or in drug abuse, or be frequent users of alcoholic beverages. Awarded funds are sent to the student's school as soon after the term deadlines as possible. **Students are required to complete a new application and send the most recent school transcripts each semester to be considered for the upcoming term.** All eligible applicants are required to maintain an average passing grade, with a minimum 2.0 GPA for the most recent semester. Awarded funds are sent to the student's school as soon after the term deadlines as possible.

## **APPLICATION PROCEDURE:**

- 2. **For applicants who have not yet attended college:** You or your high school may send a transcript directly by mail or by email to <a href="mailto:scholarships@highgroundadvisors.org">scholarships@highgroundadvisors.org</a>. Be sure that it arrives before the relevant application deadline.
  - **For applicants who have attended college:** You or your institution may send the most recent copy of your transcript, including the most recent semester, directly to HighGround Advisors either by mail or by email to <a href="mailto:scholarships@highgroundadvisors.org">scholarships@highgroundadvisors.org</a>. Be sure that it arrives before the relevant application deadline.
- 3. Submit all paperwork by the following deadlines:
  - Spring Term: Submit Application and Transcript between NOVEMBER 24, 2025, and JANUARY 9, 2026
  - SUMMER SCHOLARSHIPS ARE NOT GRANTED
  - Late applications are ineligible
  - A new application and your most recent transcript are required each semester.
